Fly Casting Lessons

Roll casting

The roll cast is one of the most useful casts an angler can learn, but is often neglected. This is the cast many improving anglers need to learn before attempting the basic moves of the Spey casts. The Roll cast and its subtle variations can be your friend in many tight corners.

This Lesson includes basic assembly of rod and initial placing the line on the water.

Part one: The principles of the Roll cast, when to use it, and how to use it safely in awkward winds, what is good form, and how to correct faults when (if!) they crop up.

These two lessons can be taken back to back as one lesson

Part two: Gaining distance with the roll cast, and changing direction. Utilising what we have learnt in a real life type fishing situation i.e. no room for anything, trees and obstructions all around,

If time permits we will conclude with a short demonstration of the jump roll, a fundamental part of Spey casting.

This lesson can take around two hours depending on individual requirements and abilities, we do have some experience with disabled students, if there are any issues you feel are affecting your casting please let me know in advance, if possible.

All anglers require a national rod fishing license.
